



Dear Parents

This is to inform you that a case of head lice/nits have been identified in your child's classroom.

Lice are parasitic insects that attach to human hair and can cause intense itching and discomfort. Nits are the tiny eggs. Lice are contagious and can be easily passed from one person to another. Although lice do not transmit diseases, they can be a nuisance. If left untreated the affected individual's scalp may become increasingly subject to secondary infection.

If your child has signs of lice/nits such as itchy scalp, or is scratching his or her scalp intensely, please begin treatment at home and notify your child's school nurse or school administrator. See attached information sheet.
